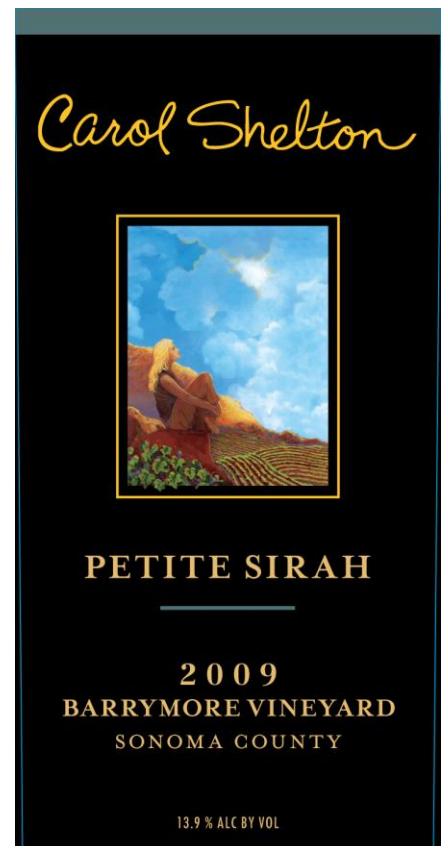

Winemaker's Tasting Notes:	Inky blue-purple in color, lively black peppery spice on warm, earthy, dark fruit. Cedary cigar box, very dark (baking) chocolate, bit of warm vanilla at finish, bright acidity and structured tannins for aging.

Fermentation Characteristics:	10 days on skins, fermented in T-bins, punched down by hand 2-3 times/day
