Winemaker's Tasting Notes: Very complexly layered spice and black fruits, pretty blueberry fragrance,
Creamy oak, a bit of vanilla, dark chocolate, brown spices-nutmeg/cinnamon.
Rich in mouth, good structure for aging, a bit chewy in its youth.
