Winemaker's Tasting Notes: Very complexly layered black fruits, deep and dark and brooding.

Freshly ground black pepper, augmented by full spice cupboard. Cedary, creamy oak, a bit of vanilla, a touch of aromatic blueberry. Rich in mouth, good structure for aging, a bit chewy in its youth.
