Old Vine Zinfandel Mancini Vineyard, Russian River Valley

Winemaker's Tasting Notes: Very complexly layered black fruits, deep and dark and brooding.

> Freshly ground black pepper, augmented by full spice cupboard. Cedary, creamy oak, a bit of vanilla, a touch of aromatic blueberry. Rich in mouth, good structure for aging, a bit chewy in its youth.

Harvest Date: October 28, 2013 26.4°Brix (soaked) Average Brix at Harvest:

Fermentation Characteristics: 3 days cold soak prior to ferment

18 days total on skins

100% bin-fermented & punched down by hand

Total Acidity: 0.68 gm/100ml

pH: 3.44 pH


