

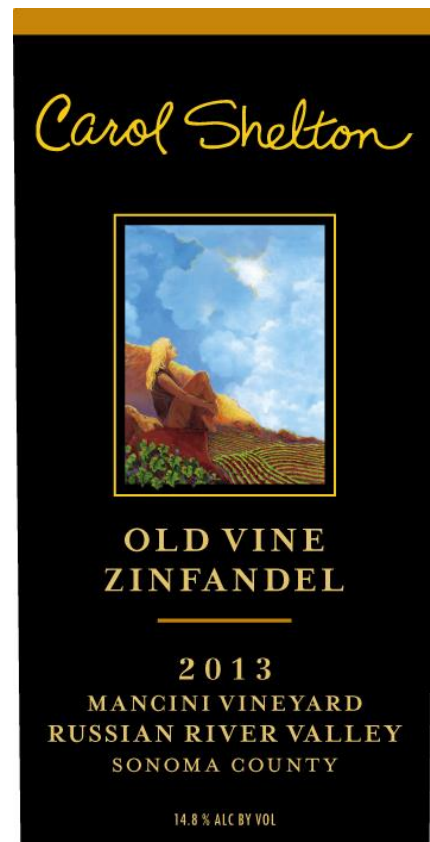

Old Vine Zinfandel
Mancini Vineyard, Russian River Valley

Winemaker's Tasting Notes:	Very complexly layered black fruits, deep and dark and brooding. Freshly ground black pepper, augmented by full spice cupboard. Cedary, creamy oak, a bit of vanilla, a touch of aromatic blueberry. Rich in mouth, good structure for aging, a bit chewy in its youth.
Harvest Date:	October 28, 2013
Average Brix at Harvest:	26.4°Brix (soaked)
Average TA/pH at Harvest:	0.58 gm/100ml pH 3.45
Fermentation Characteristics:	3 days cold soak prior to ferment 18 days total on skins 100% bin-fermented & punched down by hand
Cellar Storage/Aging:	17 months in barrels—20% new French, 20% new American, and 60% 1-2 year old French
Alcohol:	14.6%
Total Acidity:	0.68 gm/100ml
pH:	3.44 pH
Varietal :	estimated 80% Zinfandel (remaining 20% is field-blend of Carignane, with Alicante Bouschet, Petite Sirah, Grand Noir, Grenache, Mataro, etc.)
Appellation :	Mancini Vineyard, Olivet Road Russian River Valley Old Vines (planted in 1922)
