ROCKPILE RESERVE Petite Sirah

Rockpile

Our *Rockpile Reserve*® titles designate a series of elegant red wines from the Rockpile AVA, 1000-2000 feet above Lake Sonoma and the Dry Creek Valley in NW Sonoma County. The Petite Sirah is the first of the series to be released. It is not a "rip your face off" Petite, but graciously styled yet full bodied fruit, and packed with black pepper and sweet oak.

Winemaker's Tasting Notes: Inky blue-purple in color, lively black peppery spice on

deep blue-blackberry fruit, very jammy. Cedary oak spice, very dark chocolate, bit of warm vanilla at finish, structured tannins for aging.


