Larson Vineyard in the Sonoma side of Carneros is owned by our friend and fellow home brewer, Ken Larson. In our Pinot Noir we blended 50% each of two clones: 115 and 667, both hailing from the Dijon region of Burgundy originally. We really like the complex flavors, rich fruit and spicy firm tannin structure that this wine delivers...truly a classic "iron fist in a velvet glove!"

Winemaker's Tasting Notes: Rich black cherry fruit, nice black pepper spice and touch of earth.

Firm tannins cloaked in velvety plush silkiness, nice spicy finish.

More fruit than a lot of Pinot Noirs—a Zin-lover's Pinot!
